

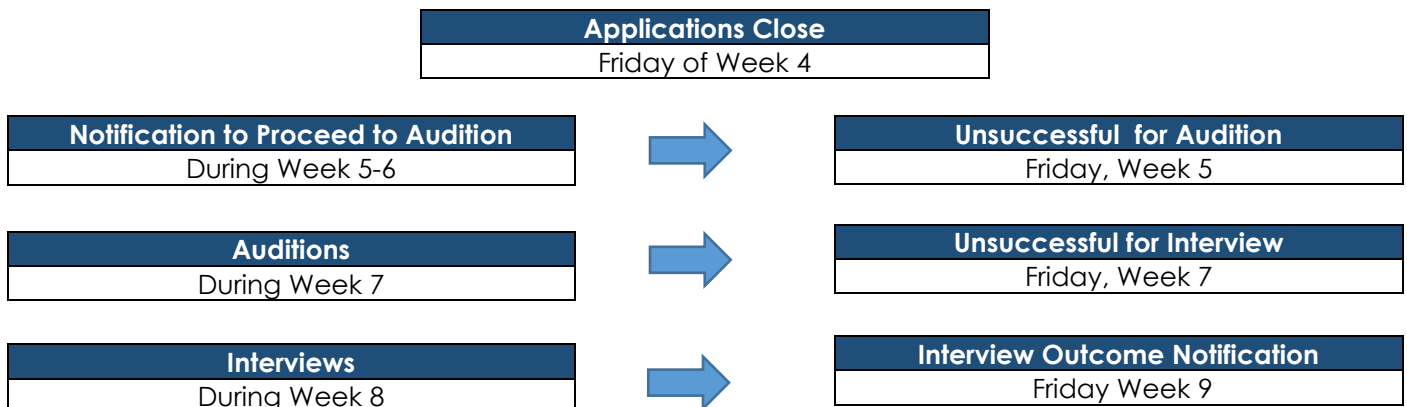

2021 Secondary Contemporary Vocal Scholarship/Placement

APPLICATION PROCESS & DATES

Applications are invited to apply for an opportunity to be considered for a 2021 Secondary Vocal Scholarship/Placement. We invite you to apply during the following periods in Term 2, Term 3 and Term 4. Applications will be accepted throughout the year and processed each term as per the below schedule. Applicants may apply once throughout the 2020 year.



PURPOSE

As a reflection of the College's motto 'Rigorous Minds | Compassionate Hearts' we are offering Contemporary Vocal Scholarships/Placements for students who are passionate about the study of Contemporary Voice and are eager to share their gift with the wider community.

SCOPE

Scholarships and Placements will be offered to students of exceptional vocal ability as a result of contemporary voice training. In addition to this, a small number of Scholarships/Placements will be allocated to students with no vocal training. These students will display an exceptional giftedness in natural tone and pitching, determined at the audition. As part of the Scholarship / Placement, the student is required to:

- Take part in individual vocal lessons¹
- Participate in the extra-curricular music activities including, but not limited to, College ensembles and out-of-school rehearsals and performances
- Join the classroom music elective
- Adhere and uphold the ethos of the College

- ¹ It is not advisable, but students can continue with external vocal tutor however, it is a requirement that external vocal tutors use repertoire suggested by South Coast Baptist College. In addition, external vocal tutor fees will not be paid for by the College.

SELECTION PROCESS

1. Completed application & fee received by due date.
2. Applicants shortlisted.
3. All applicants notified of their application status.
4. Successful applicants attend an audition.
5. Successful applicants invited to an interview with the Head of Secondary.
6. Notification of the outcome emailed to all applicants.

AUDITION REQUIREMENTS

The audition is designed to assess the candidate's current musical ability in contemporary vocals. Candidates applying for a Vocal Scholarship or Placement are advised of the following requirements **if requested to audition**:

1) *Candidates are to perform TWO contrasting pieces (10 min maximum)*

- Each piece should adequately reflect the technical ability of the candidate. Candidates may use backing tracks, with no vocals, to assist their performance. An accompanist may be used, however this is not mandatory.
- The criteria used to assess candidates in performance are:
 - Rhythm
 - Technical Skills
 - Pitch and Tone
 - Style and Expression
 - Stylistic Interpretation
 - Standard of Repertoire
 - Stage Presence

2) *Candidates will be required to undertake an aural test (3 min)*

The aural test is designed to assess the candidate's ability to accurately identify or imitate sound through aural means. The aural test may assess candidates as follows:

- Chord recognition; Major, minor
- Identify and imitate rhythmic and melodic patterns (1-2 bars)
- Pitch recognition

For the purpose of the audition, the College will provide the following equipment:

- Keyboard/Electric Piano
- CE Player/MP3 Player
- Music Stands
- Drum Kit
- Microphone and Guitar Amplifier

SCHOLARSHIP INCLUSIONS/EXCLUSIONS

The following **will be** covered for the duration of scholarship:

- 75% of College Tuition Fees (up to and including Year 12)
- Registration Fee
- Individual Music Tuition costs.

The following **WILL NOT** be covered for duration of scholarship:

- 25% of College Tuition Fees
- Enrolment Fee (\$250 due upon acceptance of scholarship/placement)
- Refundable Existing Family Enrolment Fee (\$100 due upon acceptance of scholarship/placement)
- Family Bond (\$600 due upon acceptance of scholarship/placement)
- Annual Building Levy
- Annual Year Levy

- Booklist items
- Camps - optional and compulsory
- Uniforms
- Ancillary charges

PLACEMENT INCLUSIONS/EXCLUSIONS

The following **will be** covered for the duration of scholarship:

- Registration Fee

The following **WILL NOT** be covered for duration of scholarship:

- FULL College Tuition Fees
- Enrolment Fee (\$250 due upon acceptance of scholarship/placement)
- Refundable Existing Family Enrolment Fee (\$100 due upon acceptance of scholarship/placement)
- Family Bond (\$600 due upon acceptance of scholarship/placement)
- Individual Music Tuition costs
- Annual Building Levy
- Annual Year Levy
- Booklist items
- Camps - optional and compulsory
- Uniforms
- Ancillary charges

SIBLING DISCOUNTS

For half scholarship holders, the full sibling discount will apply.

For full scholarship holders, the sibling discount will not apply for the 1st sibling. It will apply to the 2nd and other additional siblings (e.g. scholarship holder; 1st sibling – no discount; 2nd sibling – 20%; 3rd sibling – 30%; 4th+ sibling – 40%).

REVIEW & MONITORING FOR CONTINUANCE

All Scholarships/Placements are subject to review and monitoring on a Term basis with a written report being completed each Semester. For a student to continue to receive their awarded Scholarship/Placement, there are standards of behaviour and academic progress. It is an expectation that the conditions are met as per the Scholarship/Placement Agreement. Failure to meet these may result in the withdrawal of the Scholarship/Placement:

- Participate in weekly contemporary vocal tuition.
- The student must demonstrate progress.
- The student ensures the study of voice does not interfere with academic progress.
- The student takes elective music classes where offered.
- The student contributes to the music life of the school (including in/out of school rehearsals & performances).
- The student works towards AMEB graded exams or equivalent.
- The student consistently abides by the expectations laid out in the conditions of enrolment.
- The students have a high standard of behaviour and application to all subjects.
- The family ensures all fees not covered by the scholarship are paid when due. This includes all vocal tuition fees that do not form part of a Scholarship/Placement.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

1. For the growth & development of the whole College, South Coast Baptist College offers both FULL/PART Scholarships and Placements.
2. Scholarships/Placements are awarded at the full discretion of the College and no discussion will be entered into.
3. All Scholarships/Placements awarded are subject to the student & parents/guardians maintaining the conditions of the scholarship and the conditions of enrolment.

4. Scholarships cover TUITION FEES ONLY for a duration of the Scholarships (except where other conditions apply).
5. A student may apply for any number of scholarships; however, each student is eligible to receive only one (1) scholarship.
6. Attendance at specified audition, assessment or trial is essential to be eligible for a Scholarship/Placement.
7. Award of a Scholarship/Placement is conditional upon all Enrolment Fees and Family Bond being paid prior to commencement at the College.
8. Students and parents/guardians agree to actively support the College's mission, vision and values.
9. Parents/guardians undertake to support and work in co-operation with the College, promoting the best interest of all students and the College community.
10. Students are required to attend the College during the Term as per the dates published by the College. Students absent may forfeit credits for assessments missed during their absence. Student attendance is required at official College functions including, but not limited to, graduations, sporting events and camps.
11. All students are bound by the College rules and regulations issued by the Principal from time to time.
12. Parents/guardians are expected to support the College's Behaviour Management Policy and Procedures.
13. The College reserves the right to discipline students for breaches of College rules and general misbehaviour. The Principal reserves the right to suspend, or permanently exclude, a student from the College.
14. I/We have read, understood and agree to abide by the conditions of the ICT Acceptable Use E-Policy.
15. The student will participate in all normal, devotional, curricular and co-curricular activities conducted with the approval of the College.
16. Parents/guardians agree to provide their student/s with the correct uniform and support the Uniform Policies.
17. Parents/guardians agree to provide all equipment as specified in booklist.
18. The College's Financial Information document outlines all mandatory College fees and charges. Parents/guardians are jointly and individually liable for the payment of fees in accordance with the Financial Information document.
19. A credit reference check may be conducted prior or after enrolment.
20. Parents/guardians agree to advise the College of previous pending bankruptcy actions.
21. 10 school weeks (being the number of weeks excluding school holidays) notice in writing to the Principal must be given before the withdrawal of a student from the College, including at the end of the year. In lieu of such notice, a fee of 10 school weeks (or pro rata) will be charged (plus GST). This fee will only be reduced if in the view of the Principal or Business Operations Manager, extenuating circumstances that could not have been anticipated led to the withdrawal of the student. These circumstances need to be set out in a letter notifying of the intent to withdraw.
22. The payment of full fees is required to hold a guaranteed place whenever a student is absent from the College for any period during the year.
23. International students will be charged full fees (including lost Government funding).
24. Parents/guardians who enrol their student in the College agree to accept liability jointly and individually for the cost of restitution for any damage resulting from willful or negligent actions of their student.
25. The College accepts no liability for personal property brought to the College or to a College excursion or event. All reasonable steps will be taken to minimize the risk of property loss or damage.
26. Parents/guardians agree to provide the details of any mental, physical or behavioural conditions of a student enrolled at the College that may affect their learning or welfare, or the learning or welfare of another student, or the welfare of any other person at the College.
27. I/We consent to my child travelling by College bus or any form of public or private transport where such transport is considered in the reasonable opinion of the College to be necessary or desirable, for College related activities.

28. In the event of any medical emergencies arising in which the College considers it impossible or impracticable to communicate with the undersigned parents/guardians, the College will take all reasonable care of a student suffering accident or illness but will not be responsible for the costs of any ambulance, medical or dental attention or treatment administered to the student in such event, nor will it be responsible directly or indirectly for any act or omission of any medical or dental practitioner or medical officer attending or treating the student including attention provided by College staff.
29. In this agreement, the expression 'Principal' includes any delegate carrying out the duties of or exercising the authority of the Principal as delegated by the Principal.
30. The College reserves the right to amend these conditions and the College's Financial Information from time to time without prior notice.

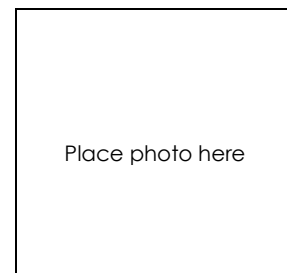
