2023 Primary School Year 1 to 6 House Cross Country Carnival

Dear Parents/Guardians

You are invited to attend the Primary House Cross Country Carnival being held on the college oval on Wednesday the 23rd of August, for all Year 1 to 6 students. Students will be competing against others in their year group, separated by gender. The focus of the Primary School House Cross Country is on maximum participation, and all students in these year groups will have the opportunity to run.

Parents, guardians and friends are more than welcome to come and watch students compete on the day. Please be aware that all parents, guardians and visitors will need to sign in at the front office if they are staying on campus to watch the races.

Further Details

Uniform: All Year 1 to 6 Students need to wear their SCBC Sports uniform on Wednesday, the 23rd of August. For this event, only students are also permitted to wear their College House Polo if they wish to. Coloured ribbons, zinc and hairspray are permitted.

Program: A program indicating the scheduled start times of races is listed below. If inclement weather is experienced on the morning, races may be postponed. Classes will be required to be out on the oval 10 minutes before their race.

Participation: All students will participate in the cross country unless a note has been sent by a parent requesting that a child does not participate.

Results: 1st to 8th place runners in each event will receive ribbons on the day. The top 3 runners from each race will be awarded medals after all students in the year-group have finished their races. The House Cross Country trophy will be presented to the winning House Captains at the Year 6B Assembly on Friday the 1st of September. The top four students in each of these races from Years 3 to 6 will then represent the College at the CPSSA Interschool Cross Country meet in Manning Park in Munster on Thursday the 7th of September.

Spectator Area / Information: Guests including parents, guardians and visitors are most welcome to attend, and watch students compete, but are asked to stay within the allocated spectator area. Recess and Lunch break times will take place at their normal time as indicated on the program and the final event is scheduled to finish by 2:30pm. Please note that any parent wishing to use toilet facilities must use those located near the Canteen, at the Library or College Reception. All other toilets are strictly for student use.
