Job Description

- Show sensitivity to and competence in detecting differing ability levels within class groups, taking responsibility for both student learning and curriculum delivery.

- Well-organised and professionally presented.
- Possess a creative and engaging teaching style, showcasing inclusive classroom practices.
- Excellent collaborative skills for working effectively with colleagues.
- Display an understanding of different learning styles and the ability to differentiate teaching styles in the classroom.
