Position Summary

South Coast Baptist College's Primary School is seeking a dedicated educator to join as a full-time Year 5 Teacher. The successful candidate will be responsible for providing high-quality instruction to a class of 30 students, adhering to the West Australian Curriculum standards. This permanent role involves collaborative work within the Primary School team, engaging students in effective learning experiences, and participating in extracurricular activities.

Job Description

The primary responsibilities include curriculum development, professional development, and embodying personal qualities conducive to effective teaching. Curriculum development entails planning and implementing a comprehensive teaching and learning program, utilizing tools such as the Compass database for student information management. Professional development involves attending staff meetings and undertaking targeted learning activities. Personal qualities required include organizational skills, creativity in teaching, collaborative abilities, and an understanding of diverse learning styles.

Position Requirements – Education & Experience:

The ideal candidate should hold suitable qualifications in education, have current registration with the Teachers Registration Board of Western Australia, possess a valid Working with Children Card and police clearance, and demonstrate experience in primary education.

- Collaborate with school leadership and support staff.
