Position Summary

South Coast Baptist College is seeking an energetic and passionate Art Teacher to join our Primary team in a **part-time, permanent role**. In 2026 we will have 308 students in years 4 to 6, with over 680 students from Kindergarten to Year 6. This position will involve working alongside classroom teachers in more than one classroom. Our Primary School provides a Christ-centred and supportive learning environment where every child is known and encouraged to thrive.

The successful applicant will:

- Design and deliver engaging, differentiated Visual Arts programs for students in Years 4–6, in line with the Western Australian Curriculum
- Create a positive, inspiring and well-managed art learning environment where students feel safe to explore, experiment and express their creativity
- Effectively use a range of media, techniques and technologies to develop students' skills, confidence and appreciation of the visual arts
- Collaborate with classroom teachers, specialist staff, parents and the wider College community to enrich student learning and wellbeing through the arts
- Embrace and actively support the mission and values of South Coast Baptist College in all aspects of teaching and learning

This is a rewarding opportunity to inspire young artists, contribute to a vibrant and creative school culture, and grow professionally within a collaborative and future-focused team.

Job Description

We are seeking a motivated and enthusiastic teacher, with a passion for teaching Art Specialisation to middle and upper primary school aged children, who has a willingness to care for and connect with students, parents and staff. A strong knowledge of West Australian Primary Arts curriculum content, and pedagogy is desirable.

The successful applicant will require abilities in the following areas:

1. Knowledge of the SCSA West Australian Visual Curriculum and its implementation in a Primary School context
2. Strong communication skills
3. Excellent teaching standards
4. A willingness to work as part of a team; closely collaborating with other Primary School Staff
5. Commitment to excellence in learning for all students
6. Ability to meet deadlines.



Selection Criteria

To successful applicant will have:

- Suitable qualifications in the field of education are expected with a minimum standard being a Primary Teaching Diploma and Bachelor Qualifications specializing in Art (4 years trained) or alternately an Arts degree with a Graduate Diploma in Education.
- Possess excellent classroom management skills, ensuring a safe and inclusive learning environment that meets the needs of students of differing ability levels.
- Demonstrate strong communication and interpersonal skills, effectively collaborating with colleagues, parents, and the broader school community.
- Demonstrate a commitment to the values and ethos of an independent/private school, along with the ability to inspire and engage students in their learning.
